Probably the most far-out materials on World War II revisionism have been the seemingly scholarly studies of the supposed execution of 6 million Jews by Hitler. The anonymous author of *The Myth of the Six Million* (whose writing style and use of footnotes internal to the text resembles Hoggan's *The Myth of the "New History"* to a remarkable extent) has presented a solid case against the Establishment's favorite horror story—the supposed moral justification for our entry into the War. (*The Myth of the Six Million*. [Hollywood: New Christian Crusade Church, 1969]) The untranslated books by the former Buchenwald inmate, Prof. Paul Rassinier, have seriously challenged the story: *Le Mensonge d'Ulysse* (1949), *Ulysse trahi par les Siens* (1960), *Le Veritable Proces Eichmann* (1962), and *Le Drame des Juifs European* (1964). A recent and very inexpensive book in magazine form, *Did Six Million Really Die?*, appeared in 1973, written by Richard Harwood. (Surrey, England: Historical Review Press) One thing is certain: 6 million executions or not, we did not intervene when the Soviet Union executed millions of kulaks—the private owners of small farms, prior to their expropriation and liquidation by Stalin in the late 1920's and early 1930's. The kulaks, unfortunately for them, had no supporters writing editorials in the *New York Times*.



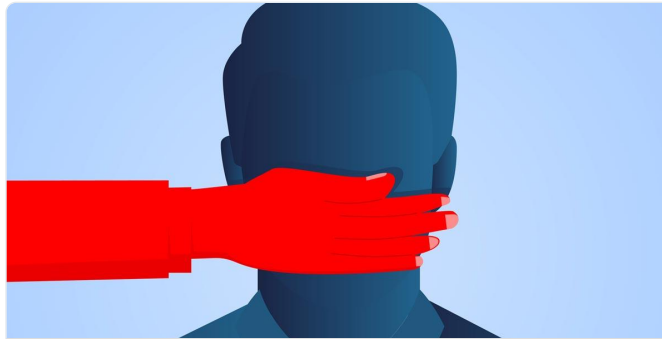

The concept of a collaborative circle clarifies how someone who viewed the world in exclusively racial terms could collaborate with a libertarian committed to ideological individualism which, on the surface, would reject racism and state-centered authoritarianism. A major figure within this circle, libertarian ideologue Murray N. Rothbard (1926-1995), always bristled at the notion that libertarian World War II revisionism revealed authoritarian sympathies: "Libertarian Revisionists, have been continually accused of being tools or sympathizers of the Kaiser, of the Nazis, or of the Communists," he wrote, a ridiculous charge, he claimed, given the "imbecility of thinking for one moment that a libertarian can really be a Nazi or a Communist." Yet, the history of Holocaust denial in the United States shows that self-proclaimed libertarians like Rothbard worked closely with antisemitic writers in developing an isolationist account of World War II. For example, Rothbard was on a first-name basis with Willis Carto as early as 1956, telling Carto that his antisemitic newsletter, *Right* was "doing a fine job!" and how impressed Rothbard was that Carto was publishing the work of Charles Smith, editor of *Truth Seeker: A Journal for Reasoners and Racists*.<sup>3</sup>

Rothbard's background as a secular Jew from New York did not prevent him from espousing antisemitism. According to one of his former students, Rothbard privately preached "rational anti-Semitism," which meant Rothbard hated "*Jews as a class of people*. I can't tell you how many times, in early correspondence, there were references to 'those fucking kikes.'" Following the common libertarian argument that the state was rooted in violence and coercion, Rothbard told Barnes that he "favored the absolute destruction of the state of Israel." According to Rothbard, while "bellyaching about the 6 million *ad nauseum*, the Israelis have gloried in genocide, the cancerous continual series of conquests and sneak attack and *blitzkrieg* of which Hitler was constantly accused by these same Zionists." Rothbard believed "the Zionist emphasis on the 6 million is particularly meretricious in view of the fact that the Zionist policy was that they would rather see Jewish refugees in Europe die there than have them leave Europe [during World War II]."<sup>29</sup> Rothbard was receptive to "6mm revisionism." By 1961, Hoggan,


As soon as World War II was over (with its enormous consequent increase in statism, militarism, and socialism in the United States), the US and Britain felt they had to launch a Cold War to oust Russia from the dominance over Eastern Europe which it had obtained as a natural consequence of the joint defeat of Germany. How much longer is the United States to play with the fate of the American people, or even the human race itself, for the sake of imposing a solution of our own liking on Eastern Europe? And if we should wage a **holocaust** to "destroy communism," and there should (doubtfully) be any Americans remaining, how distinguishable from communism will the American system, in reality, be?

Now revisionism teaches us that this entire myth, so prevalent then and even now about Hitler, and about the Japanese, is a tissue of fallacies from beginning to end. Every plank in this nightmare evidence is either **completely untrue or not entirely the truth**. If people should learn this intellectual fraud about Hitler's Germany, then they will begin to ask questions, and searching questions, about the current World War III version of the same myth. Nothing would stop the current headlong flight to war faster, or more surely cause people to begin to reason about foreign affairs once again, after a long orgy of emotion and cliché.

"Revisionism has the general function of bringing historical truth to a public that had been drugged by wartime lies and propaganda."  
We are still, in the last analysis, suffering from the delusion of Woodrow Wilson: that "democracies" *ipso facto* will never embark on war, and that "dictatorships" are always prone to engage in war. **Much as we may and do abhor the domestic programs of most dictators (and certainly of the Nazis and Communists), this has no necessary relation to their foreign policies;** indeed, many dictatorships have been passive and static in history, and, contrarily, many democracies have led in promoting and waging war. Revisionism may, once and for all, be able to destroy this Wilsonian myth.

Roosevelt made a speech on May 27 in which he asserted: "The war is approaching the brink of the western hemisphere itself. It is coming very close. If we couldn't conquer Great Britain across the English Channel, how could he possibly have been a conqueror of the world?" This was exactly the argument made at the time by several U.S. senators, including the great orator Senator Robert Taft (R-Ohio).

And looking back from the present, the same thing is clearly evident: the British occupied France, which was forced to speak German, how can American's keep repeating the lie that we would all be speaking German right now if the U.S. military hadn't intervened to stop Hitler? If it was unnecessary for Britain and France to fight against Germany, as Patrick J. Buchanan powerfully and compassionately argues in *Churchill, Hitler, and the Unnecessary War: How Britain Lost Its Empire and the West Lost the World* (Crown Publishers, 2008), it was certainly more unnecessary for the United States to do so. And if Switzerland could remain neutral during World War II, then so could the United States.

Hitler never wanted war with Britain. He wanted absolute power in Germany. He wanted to be a great German historical figure like Bismarck. He wanted to overturn the injustices of the Versailles Treaty. He wanted to restore German lands and people. He wanted to enlarge the German empire to the east. He wanted to cleanse Germany of Jews and other inferior races. He wanted to destroy Bolshevism. He wanted Germany to achieve economic self-sufficiency in Europe. Whether these things were right or wrong is immaterial. Hitler never wanted war with Britain, and certainly not with the United States. He never wanted a two-front war, let alone a world war. He wanted Germany to be a world power, not the ruler of the world. He wanted a friendly or neutral Britain, not a hostile or rival Britain.

The greatest blunder in British history was not Munich, where Chamberlain "appeased" Hitler, but the Polish war guarantee that committed Britain to fight for an anti-Semitic Polish dictatorship that had considered making a preemptive strike against Germany, signed, like Stalin, a nonaggression pact with Hitler, and joined in the dismemberment of Czechoslovakia after the Munich Agreement.

All rational Americans agree that we shouldn't get involved in the Russia-Ukraine War. The neocon warmongers with brain dead Biden as their figurehead want to destroy Russia, and they are willing to risk nuclear war to do it. But this doesn't negate what I've just said. These monsters are anything but rational. But speaking of monsters leads to another question. Everybody knows John Quincy Adams's line: "America goes not abroad in search of monsters to destroy." It's unfortunately true that, wherever the West finds an enemy in the 21<sup>st</sup> Century, "concentration camps" are sure to be present, real or otherwise.

Now there were terrible atrocities, but they were **after the bombings**. In fact, if you look at the British parliamentary inquiry, they actually reached the astonishing conclusion that, until January 1999, most of the crimes committed in Kosovo were attributed to the KLA guerrillas.

"So later they added charges [against Milosevic] about the Balkans, but it wasn't going to be an easy case to make. The worst crime was Srebrenica but, unfortunately for the International Tribunal, there was an intensive investigation by the Dutch government, which was primarily responsible—their troops were there—and what they concluded was that not only did Milosevic not order it, but he had no knowledge of it. And he was horrified when he heard about it. So it was going to be pretty hard to make that charge stick."

Meanwhile, we find some Leftists blaming possible expansion of NATO to include Ukraine. It didn't matter that NATO expansion was driven more by the East Europeans than by Washington, which was originally quite divided on the matter. Nor did it matter that NATO membership for Ukraine was hardly imminent, or that in no scenario was a NATO attack on Russia imaginable.

At the other extreme of the political spectrum, the far-right website "Antiwar.com", run by Justin Raimondo - a protégé of the anti-immigrant Republican politician Pat Buchanan - was launched in opposition to NATO intervention in Bosnia. The website still provides a forum for Balkan genocide denial on the part of its regular Balkan columnists, the Bosnian Serb emigre Veljko Matić, who like other emigres of the kind has forgotten nothing and learnt nothing, but continues to fight the Great Serb nationalist corner behind the flag of an anti-war position, writing of the "genocide" that purportedly took place in Srebrenica:

The arguments of the anti-war people about the Balkans have been related time and time again; readers are referred to the excellent website [Slobodan Milosevic](#), and to my own article on the subject, [The Left Escapade](#). Rather than wade through the gutter of their lies again, my intention here is merely to make some observations about what makes this separate group.

1) They all represent political traditions that, in the present age, are self-evidently bankrupt, defeated and irrelevant.

Human dingies in the last legs of Third Worldist anti-Western radicalism. During the 1970s, he and Noam Chomsky wrote an infamous article minimizing the crimes of Pol Pot and the Khmer Rouge ("Distortions at Fourth Hand", *The Nation*, June 25, 1977), which were allegedly being exaggerated by the Western media, much as the crimes of Milosevic and Bosnian Serbs are in Hermez's view, being exaggerated by the Western media today. Hermez's defense of Serb war-crimes represents an even more desperate attempt to scrape a worthy cause from the bottom of the increasingly empty barrel of anti-imperialism; to perceive some "progressive" content in the succession of anti-Western that represents that the generation of self-serving radicals misapprehend their lives collecting: Stalin, Mao, Pol Pot, Che Guevara, Maoists and now Milosevic.

Raimondo looks back nostalgically to an eighteenth-century republican "Golden Age" in America, in which even the presidents owned black slaves, where women could not vote and white Americans were free to hunt Indian and native Americans to their basic content - and without giving much in the way of taxes. Although the American Republic achieved its independence through the military assistance of the French, Spanish and Dutch - who fortunately did not adopt an anti-war position - this is somewhat suitably forgotten by American right-wingers of Raimondo's ilk, who have made a religion out of opposing US military assistance to foreign nations. The war in which these right-wingers most object retroactively, is Lincoln's war to crush the Southern slave-owners' separatist revolt in the 1860s - something that has really been going wrong since then, from first Roosevelt's war against Hitler and Stalin's war to oust Saddam were simply further steps in the wrong direction. Their retrospective support for the "national rights" of Southern slave-owners against Lincoln translates seamlessly into support for the "national sovereignty" of Saddam, Milosevic and other anti-Western tyrants against Bush and Blair.

Matić repeats the same tired propaganda that Serb nationalists have been repeating ad infinitum since time began (or so it often feels like to some of us): Albanians are "national barbarians" in the world; Croats are "Islamic" and the whole world is against the Serbs. Rather than concern Serbian war-crimes - as one might expect from a genuine anti-war columnist - Matić's entire effort consists of condemning anyone who actually opposes these crimes. Western journalists who report them, Serbian human-rights activists who campaign against them, the Hague Tribunal which prosecutes them. For the record it is not 8,000 bodies that were laid to rest in the mass graves at Srebrenica, but that the perpetrators are being prosecuted. Since the cause of a Great Serbia has been utterly defeated and discredited, it is left to Matić to vent his rage at the West that is indignantly responsive to the "truth" which is the usual Great Serb self-pity and abdication of responsibility. He expresses this in unduly restricted and largely unimpressive terms against what he calls the "Hague equation" - as if the war-crimes suspects at the Hague were being punished for their beliefs rather than for their actions, and as if they were being tortured to confess.

What matters is that the preening moralists of the interventionist "Left" feel good about themselves and can pat themselves on the back for having stopped "genocide." That was the word Rep. Nancy Pelosi used to describe what was going on in Bosnia and Kosovo, as I questioned her support for Clinton's war at a public meeting. Her **bugged-out eyes** bulged and seemed almost to pop out of their sockets as she exclaimed in horror that of course U.S. military intervention was a moral necessity. Hitler-Nazis-"ethnic cleansing" - all the by-now-familiar buzzwords used by the neons to justify the invasion and occupation of Iraq were trotted out and tested first by the Nancy Pelosis of this world, as they defended a war against a country that had never attacked us and posed no threat, either to our territory or our legitimate interests.

As it turned out, however, the "genocide" was greatly exaggerated: indeed, it was almost entirely the product of war propaganda, as John Laughland and others revealed to an indifferent world in the war's aftermath. We started out hearing of as many as 100,000 victims of Milosevic's "ethnic cleansing," as CNN (then popularly known as the Clinton News Network) assured us. Then, somehow, they decided to pare down the number to around 50,000; however, as the war ended, and the number of bodies seemed hardly in accordance with this estimate, they reduced it to 10,000. But where, critics still wondered, were the bodies? Apparently nowhere to be found. In the end, the truth came out, as it usually does, albeit far too late to prevent an immoral and precedent-setting war: what happened in Kosovo was not an ethnic cleansing, but a civil war, in which the body count showed a nearly equal number of deaths on both sides. The total number of victims, including Kosovars, Serbs, Roma, and others, was under 10,000.

## John Laughland? Ah yes, Ron Paul Institute Academic Board member

But Rockwell isn't the nuttiest of the people associated with the institute—not even close.

That honor likely belongs to the Dickensian-named John **Laughland**, a British writer who has never met a Central or Eastern European autocrat he didn't like. A prominent defender of the late Serbian President Slobodan Milosevic, **Laughland** penned a book on his Hague war-crimes trial titled *Travesty* (the "travesty" in question not being the Bosnian Serb genocide of Muslims, which **Laughland** **denies** ever took place, but the "kangaroo court" that brought Milosevic to justice and which **Laughland** blamed for his 2006 death). **Laughland** has also defended Ukraine's Kremlin-backed president Viktor Yanukovich (whose attempt to steal the 2004 election sparked that country's peaceful Orange Revolution) and **lamented the fate** of Belarusian President Alexander Lukashenko, Europe's last dictator, victim of "humiliating treatment" at the hands of a "propaganda campaign waged against" him "by the West."

Animating **Laughland's** defense of these loathsome individuals is his belief that "Washington is promoting a system of political and military control not unlike that once practiced by the Soviet Union." But the common thread uniting these alleged victims of Western imperialism is their resistance to the democratizing, liberal reforms insisted upon by the U.S., the European Union, and NATO, not to mention their chumminess with Vladimir Putin's Russia.

**Laughland** is joined in this venture by fellow Ron Paul Institute board member and Oxford historian Mark Almond. The two are trustees of a sinister and deceptively named organization, the British Helsinki Human Rights Group (BHHRG), which trades on the good name of the international civil liberties monitoring organizations founded as a result of the 1975 Helsinki accords.

The BHHRG was an early defender of Milosevic and Serbian behavior in the Balkans generally; **Laughland** has **argued** that it is NATO leaders, and not the wartime Serbian political and military leadership, who should be tried for war crimes. (**Laughland** has long claimed that reports of Serbian-created mass graves in Kosovo were either **fabricated** or **exaggerated**). Almond **referred** to Belarus's 2006 presidential election as a "landslide" for Lukashenko, "demonized" because "after the death of Slobodan Milosevic, the West did not need to look far to find another bogeyman." The election results were rejected by the Organization for Security and Cooperation in Europe; EU leaders **deplored** the farce as "a sad exception ... on a continent of open and democratic societies."

In addition, the BHHRG regularly advocates positions that regurgitate Russian nationalist talking points, minimize xenophobic and illiberal attitudes prevalent in the former Eastern bloc, or excuse authoritarian tendencies. Its website, for instance, **claims** that the Baltic republic of Latvia was "incorporated" into the Soviet Union, not violently invaded by Stalin (who sent over 100,000 Latvians to the gulag) and occupied for nearly half a century, all of which is a "myth." Daniel McAdams, Paul's erstwhile congressional foreign-policy adviser and the new executive director of his institute, who has "monitored" elections for the BHHRG, published an article for Rockwell's website referring to Lukashenko's "authoritarianism" in scare quotes.



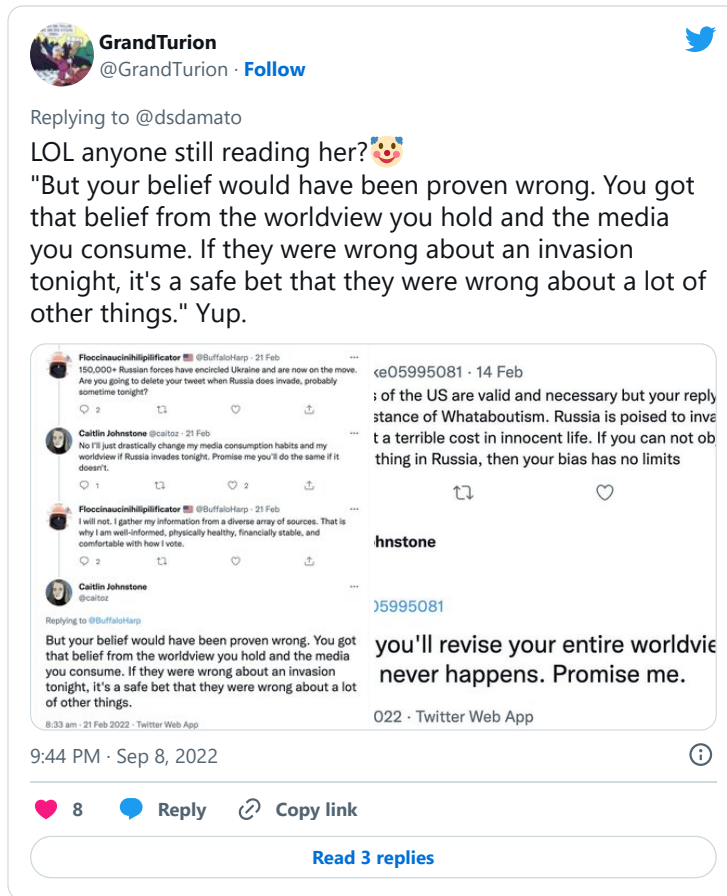

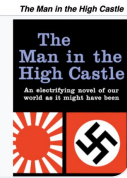
