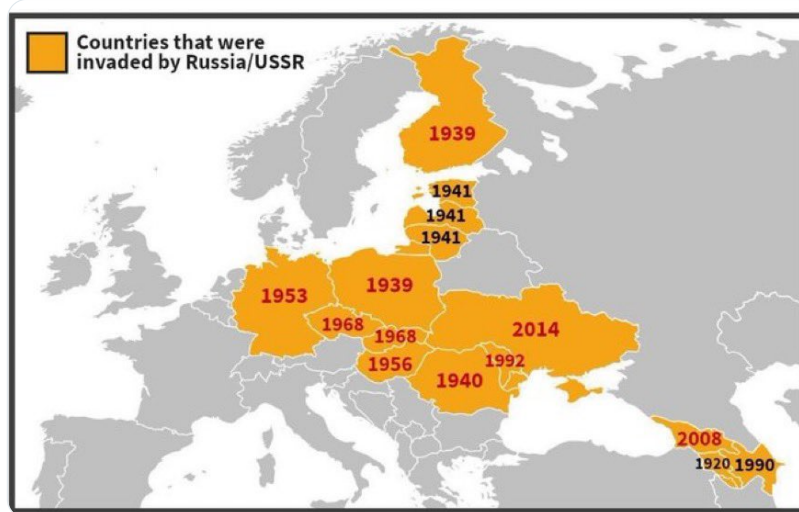
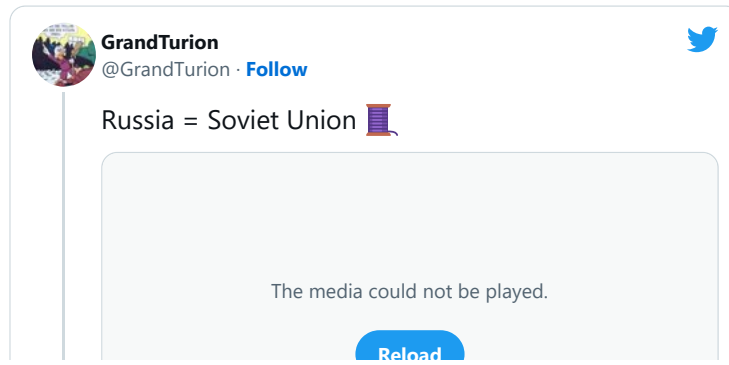

And this is—it's not working, and what Putin is saying in general is: lay off; back away. You cannot run war exercises all the time on our borders; you cannot talk this language of calling us the aggressor. And that's what's very interesting to me, is the United States media always say—every day I see it in the newspaper or this or that—the Russian invasion, the coming Russian invasion of Ukraine.

Now, this is outrageous, because first of all, they have no proof that Russia intends to invade Ukraine; I doubt that they would. I think Russia is concerned only with the Donbass region. The Donbass region being the eastern sector where the Russian-speaking people are threatened by the Ukrainian government. Why? Because, we saw back in 2014, they were killing them. There was quite a bit of murder going on, and the Ukrainian government did not want to recognize the historic autonomy of the eastern Ukraine, of the people who speak Russian. **In fact, Russian language was banned in Ukraine, if you remember correctly.**

With the standard of living and growth rates rapidly rising, ordinary Chinese have never been better off. But that does not satisfy the "human rights" crowd: far from it. China may be taking the capitalist road, they carp, but it is still a long way from achieving "democracy." This obsession with capital-d Democracy overshadowed Clinton's trip to China, and so skewed the focus of the American media, and, ultimately, the President himself, that the main subject of public discussion was not the dramatic achievements of the post-Mao destatization, in which a billion people lifted themselves up out of serfdom. Instead, the President engaged in an hour-long colloquy with Chinese premier Jiang Zemin on the 1989 **Tiananmen Square incident, in which a few hundred rioters bent on self-immolation** achieved their stated ends.

THE MYTH OF TIANANMEN

The Tiananmen Square "massacre" is an incident so wrapped up in mythology, most of it generated by Western journalists and their professional dissident friends, that it is nearly impossible for any "revisionist" analysis to be given a hearing. The world saw the Goddess of Democracy, the bright banners and youthful idealism of the protesters, a giant rock-concert held under the gaze of the seemingly incongruous Chairman Mao, whose gargantuan portrait dominates the Square.

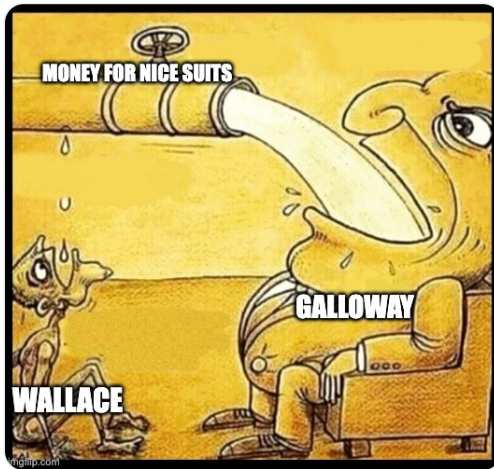

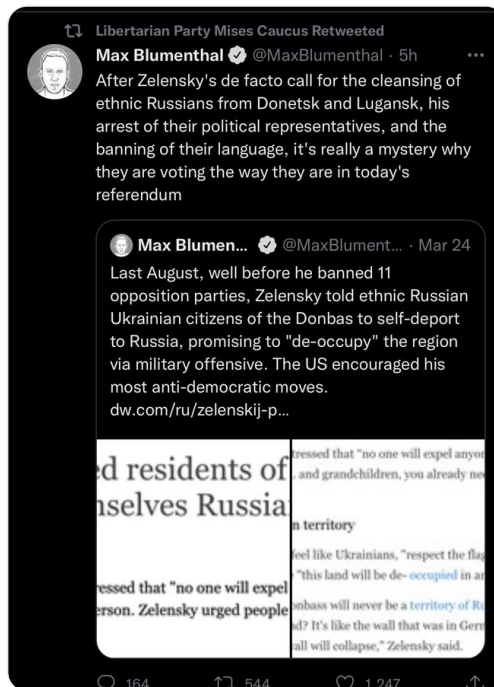

journalist Max Blumenthal.^[14] The website, initially founded as *The Grayzone Project*,^[16] was affiliated with AlterNet before becoming independent in early 2018.^[11] A fringe website,^[23] *The Grayzone* is known for misleading reporting^[24] and sympathetic coverage of authoritarian regimes.^{[11][15][25]} *The Grayzone* has denied human rights abuses against Uyghurs,^[29] promulgated conspiracy theories about Venezuela, Xinjiang, Syria and other regions,^{[30][31]} and promoted pro-Russian propaganda during the Russian invasion of Ukraine.^[28] *The Grayzone* has been described by *Commentary* as a propaganda shop devoted to pushing pro-Assad, pro-Maduro, pro-Putin, and pro-Hamas narratives.^[32]

In December 2015, Blumenthal was invited to Russia Today's tenth-anniversary party. Of course, there were many interesting and famous people at that party, besides Putin and the channel heads. For example, retired lieutenant general and former director of US military intelligence Michael Flynn. As it became known later, Flynn was paid 45 thousand dollars for his performance at the party. American journalist Eric Alterman, who writes for *The Nation*, named other people who received speaking fees. Blumenthal was among them. Max never confirmed financial ties with RT — he only wrote about his love for the channel and its "impartiality and objectivity" in covering events. He criticized the US for recognizing the media as a "foreign agent."

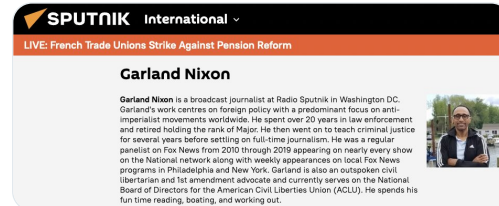

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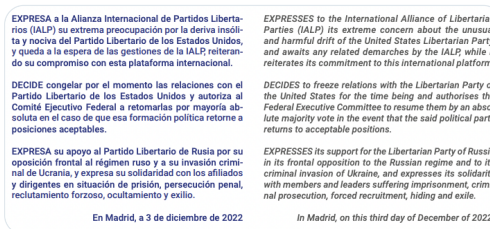
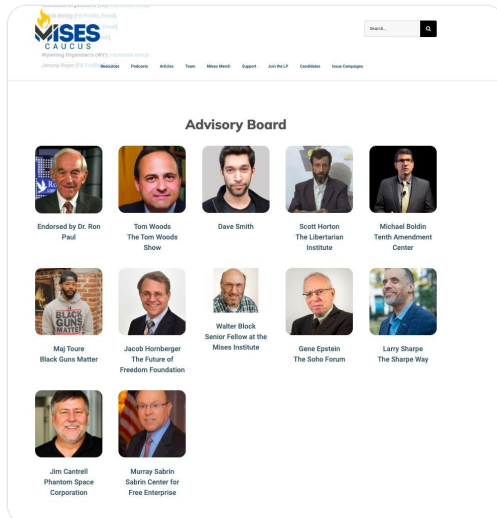

They argue this way: "It is a very deplorable fact that the peoples of Europe are fighting one another, that they have wrecked their glorious civilization and that they are consequently doomed to starvation and misery. It is no less deplorable that similar things happen in Asia. Unfortunately we cannot save them from disaster. They themselves have to learn that peaceful cooperation would be more beneficial to them than war and mutual extermination. We cannot police the whole world. All we can do is to look out for ourselves and to preserve the Western Hemisphere's independence. We will keep neutral, will not interfere with other continental affairs and thus preserve our American way of life."
But it is not without concern for America what happens in the rest of the world. The establishment of two big totalitarian empires, one on the other side of the Atlantic, one on the other side of the Pacific, would have been a tremendous menace to America's political independence. The German nationalists had always emphasized that the last goal of their ambitions was the conquest of a large colonial domain on the American continent. The present writer is not familiar with the Japanese language and does not know whether Japanese economists and publicists were equally frank in their printed utterances. But he knows from conversations with many Japanese professors and students that they considered the Americans and not the Chinese, their main
...protectionism and still more autarky provoke conflicts.
The Second World War was not caused by Nazism alone. The failure of all other nations to erect in time a barrier against a possible aggression was no less instrumental in bringing about the disaster than the plans of the Nazis and the other Axis powers. If the Nazis had expected to encounter on the first day of hostilities a united and adequately armed front of all those nations which later came united in fighting them, they would never have ventured an assault. But collective security is unrealizable among nations bitterly fighting one another in the economic sphere. Economic nationalism has divided the peace-loving nations. If the United Nations do not succeed in brushing away economic nationalism, postwar conditions will not differ from those prevailing in the years between the two World Wars. Then a third and much more dreadful war is unavoidable.
Every nation has to choose. The United States too. The alternative is: unity among the peace-loving nations or return to the chaos out of which new conflict will originate. But unity is incompatible with protection. Every day experiences show that the good neighbor policy among the American republics comes into collision with economic nationalism. How should Latin America and the European democracies enter into a close political collaboration with the United States if their citizens suffer from American foreign trade policies?
...arse, even among the Russian people there are some who do not share this attitude. It is only to be expected that they have not been able to prevail over their compatriots. Ever since Russia was first in a precise influence on European politics, it has continually behaved like a robber who lies in wait for a moment when he can pounce upon his victim and plunder him of his possessions. At no time did the Russians acknowledge any other limits to the expansion of their empire than those dictated by the force of circumstances. The position of the Bolsheviks in regard to the problem of the territorial expansion of the Russian Empire is not a whit different. They too acknowledge no other rule than that, in the conquest of new territory and indeed must go as far as one dares, with due regard to one's resources. The fortunate circumstance that saved civilization from being destroyed by the Russians was the fact that the nations which were strong enough to be able successfully to stand off the onslaught of the hordes of Russian Cossacks. The experiences of the Russians in the Napoleonic Wars, the Crimean War, and the Turkish campaigns of 1914-1917 showed them that, in spite of the great number of their soldiers, their army is unable to seize territory against Europe. The World War merely confirmed this.

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Washington's Crocodile Tears Over Ukraine's Destruction

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As of this writing, Ukrainian president Volodymyr Zelensky is [hunkered down in his bunker](#) somewhere in Kiev, as the sound of the encroaching war gets closer and closer. A grim scene, to be sure.

All the US and EU kisses and roses leading up to this end have turned to dust and barbed wire, as a no-doubt deeply bitter Zelensky has nothing left but to cry out in anger:

Zelensky earlier: "Who is ready to fight with us? I do not see anyone. Who is ready to give Ukraine a guarantee of NATO membership? Everyone is afraid."

The chips are down, as much of the US-equipped and backed Ukrainian military appears to have [turned and ran](#) as Russian forces approached. That is not to say that there has not been death and destruction on both sides. The battle for Kherson was brutal, with plenty of [Russian losses](#). But nevertheless, as of this writing, it has fallen to Russian control.

Kiev in the main may well fall within the next 12-24 hours. Russian troops are already in the city. And Zelensky is in his bunker with fewer and fewer to take his calls. The cavalry he believed was promised him will not be coming to rescue him. Ukraine will be demilitarized and Ukraine will be neutral. Once held up as a great ally of Washington and Brussels, Zelensky is alone.

It brings to mind that great quote I often recycle from RPI academic advisor John Laughland, [written as the early US-backed color revolutions](#) rampaged through the former Soviet world in the early 2000s:

[Today's apparent death of former Serbian president Slobodan Milosevic](#) bares the bloody fangs of the New World Order, a totalitarian construct of the United States and allies to fill in the post Cold War void.

"If we cannot convict you on our lies, we will at least make sure you don't get out alive."

Let us recall that Milosevic was captured – kidnapped – by the NWO shock troops in exchange for aid promised to a Serbia recently decimated by NATO bombs to halt a genocide that subsequent investigation proved a lie by the Clinton Administration and dutifully amplified in the lap-dog media.

The initial charges of genocide in Kosovo were so obviously trumped up – there was the problem of a lack of bodies – that the Hague kangaroo court was forced to drop that central part of its case. Chief prosecutor Carla del Ponte was herself quoted as saying that no genocide charges were brought against Milosevic, "because there is no evidence for it."

The court then scrambled to find something else with which to charge Milosevic, all the while Milosevic rotted away in a jail cell convicted of nothing.

According to the paper, the pup was originally named Yorgo, but the Russian prime minister is considering options.



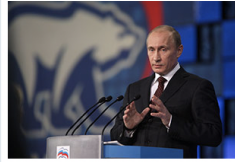

Margarita Simonovna Simonyan (Russian: Маргарита Симоновна Симоны́н; born 6 April 1980) is a Russian journalist. She is the editor-in-chief of the Russian state-controlled^{[1][2]} media organisations RT (formerly Russia Today)^[3] and *Rossiya Segodnya*.^[4]

In 2022, Simonyan was sanctioned by the European Union as "a central figure of the Russian Government propaganda" responsible for "actions and policies which undermine the territorial integrity, sovereignty and independence of Ukraine".^[5] In January 2023, Ukraine imposed sanctions on Margarita for her support of 2022 Russian invasion of Ukraine.^[6]

Especially after the Ukrainian "Orange revolution", which Moscow perceived as a western-instigated threat to Russia's influence in the post-Soviet space, Moscow felt that it needed to step up its outreach to international audiences. That seemed to be a perfect time to return to Lesin's idea of an international TV channel. Lesin, who was then an advisor to Putin, teamed up with the Kremlin Press Secretary Alexey Gromov, and developed the idea of the **Russia Today** TV channel.

The launch of Russia Today was announced at the beginning of June 2005. A 25-year-old uber-loyal Russian journalist, **Margarita Simonyan**, was appointed the editor-in-chief, possibly on Gromov's personal recommendation – they closely worked together when she was a reporter in the Kremlin pool.

RIA Novosti was Russia's international news agency until 9 December 2013 when it became known as Rosiya Segodnya.^{[7][8]} Dmitry Kiselyov, an anchorman of the Russia-1 channel was appointed to be the first president of the reorganized agency.^[9] He soon announced that Margarita Simonyan was to be editor-in-chief. Simonyan told *The New York Times* in 2017 that she chose Sputnik as the new name "because I thought that's the only Russian word that has a positive connotation, and the whole world knows it."^[10]

Sputnik was launched on 10 November 2014 by Rosiya Segodnya, which is itself funded through RT, owned and operated by the Russian government, and was created via an Executive Order of the President of Russia on 9 December 2013.^[11] As well as the RIA Novosti news agency, Sputnik's origins can be traced to 1929 when Radio Moscow was launched as the official international broadcasting station of Soviet Union airing across the country, Eastern Europe and Cuba until it was replaced by Voice of Russia in 1993 along with the foreign language services of RIA Novosti.^[12] RT UK was launched a fortnight earlier. According to its editor-in-chief Dmitry Kiselyov, Sputnik was intended to reach a worldwide audience "bored of aggressive propaganda promoting a unipolar world and who want a different perspective".^{[13][14]} The station claims it "fills the void".^[15] However, President Vladimir Putin, while visiting the Moscow base of the RT television network in 2013, said the objective behind both the then forthcoming Sputnik agency and RT was to "break the monopoly of the Anglo-Saxon global information streams."^[16]

Ionov used his control over U.S. Political Group 1 leaders to foster discord within the United States, to spread pro-Russian propaganda under the guise of a domestic political organization, and to interfere in local elections. For example, in January 2016, Ionov guaranteed financing for — and ultimately funded — a four-city protest tour undertaken by U.S. Political Group 1 in support of a [Petition on Crimes of Genocide against African People in the United States](#), which it had previously submitted to the United Nations at Ionov's direction. Later, in 2017 and 2019, Ionov monitored and supported the St. Petersburg, Florida, political campaigns of UIC-3 and UIC-4. In 2019, before the primary election, Ionov wrote to a Russian official that he had been "consulting every week" on the campaign. After UIC-4 advanced to the general election, FSB Officer 1 wrote to Ionov that "our election campaign is kind of unique," and asked, "are we the first in history?" Ionov later sent FSB Officer 1 additional details about the election, referring to UIC-4 as the candidate "whom we supervise."

But the federal [indictment](#) Omali referenced in his press conference does contain connections to his groups. It charges Russian national Aleksandr Viktorovich Ionov with working with Russian intelligence agencies to recruit "members of U.S. political groups as foreign agents of Russia within the United States."

While not naming these political groups, the indictment describes a working relationship between Ionov and an organization it calls "U.S. Political Group 1." In August 2016, Ionov is said to have directed U.S. Political Group 1 to publish a statement of support of Russia's Olympic team as it faced a doping scandal. The indictment includes the title of that statement but redacts the name of the group: "Imperialists ban Russia from 2016 Olympic Games! U.S. Political Group 1 says 'let Russia play!'"

Today, [you can still find that statement on the website of the Burning Spear](#), the official newspaper of the African People's Socialist Party. It was published under the headline, "Imperialists ban Russia from 2016 Olympic Games! APSP says 'let Russia play!'"

If U.S. Political Group 1 is indeed the African People's Socialist Party, it also is accused of receiving cash from Russia, according to the indictment, in the form of a couple of payments in 2016 totaling about \$7,000.

Other connections to Ionov are more overt. In March, as Russia launched its war on Ukraine, Ionov joined two web conferences hosted by Omali Yeshitela, one called ["Live With Russia"](#) and the other ["Negating Colonial Lies About Russia."](#)

Reade told Semafor that a Russian U.N. diplomat reached out to her in recent weeks, saying they had seen her criticisms of the war in Ukraine on social media and her YouTube channel. Reade said she is a "longtime anti-imperialist," and that her comments stem from her frustration with "Russophobia" and the military industrial complex.

"They deflect it as Russian disinformation, which is not true," she said of Western diplomats at the United Nations. "I don't really understand the deflection or the resistance to doing simply accounting and oversight."

Fears of a Russian invasion of Ukraine are "hype and hysteria" and the presence of Russian troops near the border with Ukraine is part of normal processes, Russia's deputy ambassador to the UN has told the BBC.

Dmitry Polyanskiy told the BBC's Yalda Hakim that if Russia was not attacked or provoked, it would not initiate a war.

He said Russia respected Ukraine's sovereignty, but did not accept Ukrainian intentions to join Nato because the alliance's infrastructure on Russian borders would put Russia's security "at threat".

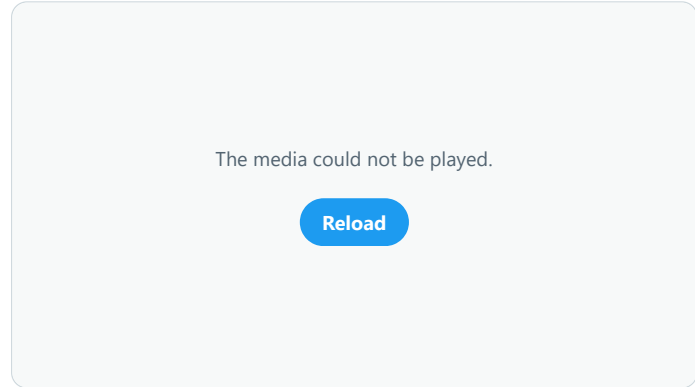


An absolute war

For the first time in history, Russia is fighting an absolute war. All previous wars were relative and prototypes, prefigurations of this one, which is the main one. Only this war is the final one, the last and irreversibly significant. It is clear that we do not yet understand it. What is happening is beyond the comprehension of even those involved in it, even those who started it. For the first time at the other end is absolute evil - not partial, not relative; it is not even the West, much less the ephemeral transient entity of so called "Ukraine", however hellish it may seem: it is something much deeper. This is humanity's last war. Only Russia, with a few others, has decisively taken the side of Truth, but has not understood how. It is for this historical moment that we, Russians, have been created. Regardless of how it ends, preparations for the Last Judgement are in full swing. The watershed is cutting across the planet: on this side or on the other. Humanity is torn apart. History is a movement from one to two. In the beginning there was only one Adam. In the end there are two: Adam and his black double.

The most terrible ghettos will be created for surfers - this is the most arrogant, most anti-Eurasian phenomenon. There is nothing more disgusting than riding with a white-toothed smile on this disgusting board. In a word, Atlanticism is our absolute enemy. There is nothing more to say here. The most important thing has been said. Whoever does not understand, nothing will help him. Nothing.

In short: "We must kill, kill and kill Ukrainians. No need to talk to them. This is my opinion as a professor." [#ProWarRally](#)
