





The veteran director has been accused of pandering to Putin for his four-hour documentary on the Russian leader, but he remains unrepentant. Could it be the climax to his career?



© Oliver Stone: 'Everything I did was examined by a certain light. And as an artist it's very limiting.'

And this is—it's not working, and what Putin is saying in general is: lay off; back away. You cannot run war exercises all the time on our borders; you cannot talk this language of calling us the aggressor. And that's what's very interesting to me, is the United States media always say—every day I see it in the newspaper or this or that—the Russian invasion, the coming Russian invasion of Ukraine.

Now, this is outrageous, because first of all, they have no proof that Russia intends to invade Ukraine; I doubt that they would. I think Russia is concerned only with the Donbass region. The Donbass region being the eastern sector where the Russian-speaking people are threatened by the Ukrainian government. Why? Because, we saw back in 2014, they were killing them. There was quite a bit of murder going on, and the Ukrainian government did not want to recognize the historic autonomy of the eastern Ukraine, of the people who speak Russian. In fact, Russian language was banned in Ukraine, if you remember correctly.





In November 2013, Galloway and his wife Gayatri began to present Sputnik for the RT network, a Russian governmentbacked station formely known as Russia Today. — In an overview of the broadcasting organisations Galloway works for, Tom Rogan in the National Review in April 2014 described him as being "a Western puppet for tynany's propagandists", in the negister of members' financial interests published at the end of January 2015, Galloway disclosed that he had earned 2203.450 from his television broadcasting in the previous year and had received almost £70,000 in travelling expenses and holds stays. For the period November 2013 for february 2015, Galloway was paid £100,000 for his appearances on RT, the highest payment to any British politician working for the channel.

In December 2015, Blumenthal was invited to Russia Today's tenthanniversary party. Of course, there were many interesting and famous people at that party, besides Putin and the channel heads. For example, retired lieutenant general and former director of US military intelligence Michael Flynn. As it became known later, Flynn was paid 45 thousand dollars for his performance at the party. American journalist Eric Alterman, who writes for The Nation, named other people who received speaking fees. Blumenthal was among them. Max never confirmed financial ties with RT — he only wrote about his love for the channel and its "impartiality and objectivity" covering events. He criticized the US for recognizing the media as a "foreign agent."

The west's friends in eastern Europe today have their hands firmly on the commanding heights of political control in their countries, just as in many cases they personally did under communist dictatorship.

"I would like to bring to your attention disturbing information recently obtained by the United States that indicates that human rights violations and abuses in the aftermath of a further invasion are being planned," said the letter, written by Bathsheba Crocker, the U.S. ambassador to the United Nations and other international organizations in Geneva.

"These acts, which in past Russian operations have included targeted killings, kidnappings/forced disappearances, unjust detentions, and the use of torture, would likely target those who oppose Russian actions," said the letter addressed to Michelle Bachelet, the U.N. high commissioner for human rights.

Crocker says the Russian military's targets would include Russian and Belarusian dissidents in exile in Ukraine, journalists and anti-corruption activists, and "vulnerable populations such as religious and ethnic minorities and LGBTQI+ persons."

That seemed to be a perfect time to return to Lesin's channel, Lesin, who was then an advisor to Putin, teamed up

with the Kremlin Press Secretary Alexey Gromov, and developed the idea of the Russia Today TV channel.

The launch of Russia Today was announced at the beginning of June 2005. A 25-year-old $uber-loyal\ Russian\ journalist, {\bf Margarita\ Simonyan}, was\ appointed\ the\ editor-in-chief,$ possibly on Gromov's personal recommendation - they closely worked together when she was a reporter in the Kremlin pool.

But the federal indictment Omali referenced in his press conference does contain connections to his groups. It charges Russian national Aleksandr Viktorovich Ionov with working with Russian intelligence agencies to recruit "members of U.S. political groups as foreign agents of Russia within the United States."

While not naming these political groups, the indictment describes a working relationship between lonov and an organization it calls "U.S. Political Group 1." In August 2016, Ionov is said to have directed U.S. Political Group 1 to publish a

statement of support of Russia's Olympic team as it faced a doping scandal. The indi includes the title of that statement but redacts the name of the group: "Imperialists ban Russia from 2016 Olympic Games! U.S. Political Group 1 says "let Russia play!"

Today, you can still find that statement on the website of the Burning Spear, the official newspaper of the African People's Socialist Party. It was published under the headline, "Imperialists ban Russia from 2016 Olympic Games! APSP says 'let Russia play."

If U.S. Political Group 1 is indeed the African People's Socialist Party, it also is accused of receiving cash from Russia, according to the indictment, in the form of a couple of payments in 2016 totaling about \$7,000.


