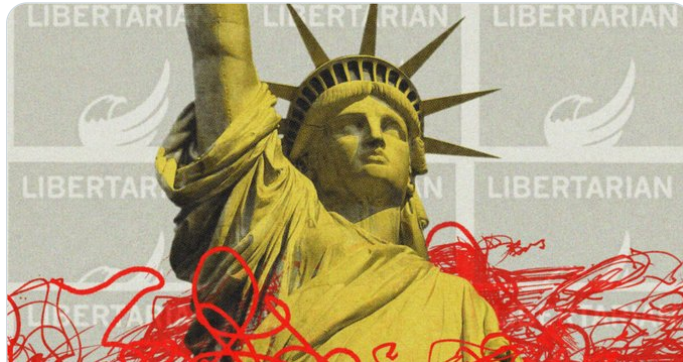

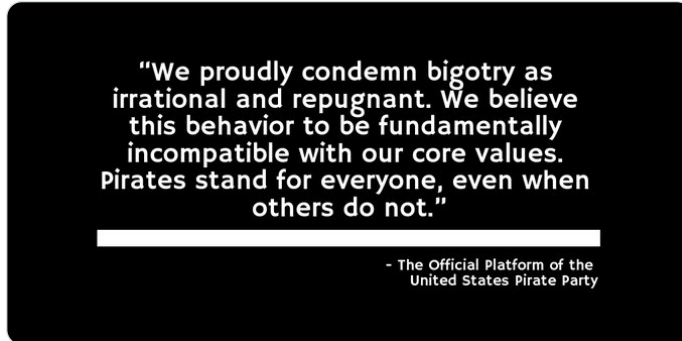

Dear Mr. Harris, Ms. McArdle, and the LNC,

This serves as my official letter of resignation as the Communications Director for the Libertarian Party. It has been the honor of my life.

My expected last day will be Friday, July 15th, 2022.

---

I came to the Libertarian Party in the second wave of the Ron Paul Revolution. I remember sitting on my very progressive friend's couch in Chicago watching the 2012 Republican Primary Debate and hearing Dr. Paul speak for the first time. Once home for the night I turned to Google to try to understand why everything he said sounded different and so much better than that coming from the other Republicans. A day later I was back at that same friend's home telling her, "I think I'm a libertarian."

I didn't even know there was a Libertarian Party at this time, but a few months later I took my first libertarian step when I wrote in Ron Paul on my presidential ballot.

Within the next year I would move back to Texas, meet my first Libertarian friends, and start getting involved in my new political home. I cut my libertarian baby teeth in the Liberty Memes and Libertarian Christian Institute Facebook groups. I soon became the Secretary of my county party, and started baking a cake each August 20th to celebrate Ron Paul's birthday. I was all in.

But that was only the beginning of my journey. I came into the Libertarian Party still firmly gripping certain statist positions I couldn't seem to let go of on my own. Looking back, I am lucky that I spent little time on Twitter back in those days; because it wasn't trolling or brash responses or harsh accusations that moved me from the "America is the good guy in all the wars" – "We obviously need to control the border and immigrants need to get in line" – "If you've done nothing wrong the police won't bother you" – baby libertarian, to the anti-war, free movement of peaceful people supporting, authority resisting, proud Libertarian that I am today.

It was thoughtful conversations with beautiful Libertarians who took the time to understand my positions and gently challenge my thinking that took the spark of liberty in my heart and grew it to an unquenching flame. That burn for freedom guided me in the roles of County Chair, State Vice Chair, and eventually National staff.

Throughout inter-party bickering and caucus wars, I focused on my job and my passion for communicating the peace and prosperity that can only come from liberty. I sought to find new ways to explain the logic of opposing government overreach, especially in the form of endless wars. It was then a particularly sad day when I heard a prominent anti-war author I had long appreciated referred to people like me – not aligned with a certain faction – as "a cancer that needs to be cut out" of the party. That hurt – but I don't hero worship, so I got back to work.

It is still time for me to remain focused. I know that I must continue using respect and empathy for my fellow humans of every background to point out the evil of the duopoly and light the path to liberty. My voice is not the voice with which this LNC wants to speak. That's okay. I know as long as there are people being victimized by the state, there will be a place for my voice. I need to go find that place now.

In stark contrast to this, Alt-Righters insist that life is also about strife, hate, struggle and fight, not just between individuals but also among various groups of people acting in concert. "Millennial Woes" (Colin Robertson) has thus aptly summarized the Alt-Right: "Equality is bullshit. Hierarchy is essential. The races are different. The sexes are different. Morality matters and degeneracy is real. All cultures are not equal and we are not obligated to think they are. Man is a fallen creature and there is more to life than hollow materialism. Finally, the white race matters, and civilization is precious. This is the Alt-Right."

Absent any unifying theory, however, there is far less agreement among the Alt-Right about the goal that it ultimately wants to achieve. Many of its leading lights have distinctly libertarian leanings, most notably those that have come here (which, of course, was the reason for having invited them here), even if they are not 100%-ers and would not identify themselves as such. All Alt-Righters that have appeared here, for instance, have been familiar with Rothbard and his work, all the while the most recent presidential candidate of the Libertarian Party had never even heard of Rothbard's name, and all of them, to the best of my knowledge, were outspoken supporters of Ron Paul during his primary campaign for the Republican Party's nomination as presidential candidate, all the while many self-proclaimed libertarians attacked and tried to vilify Ron Paul for his supposedly (you already know what's coming by now) "racist" views.

almost all of their Michigan members the best; it will be for them to save our party in the years ahead.

The same, however, cannot be said for their leadership. The amount of grift, ideological rot, nastiness and outright prejudice which I have seen in the higher ranks of the Mises Caucus simply cannot be ignored. I do not believe that these people have the best interests of the liberty movement at heart. To be blunt, I don't think they care one iota about creating a world set free in our lifetime. To the contrary, their actions have established that they would burn the national and state parties to the ground if only to have dominion over the ashes and the opportunity to monetize every smoking ember. And I suspect they will soon get their wish.

Most distressingly, I question the extent to which the Mises Caucus and its leadership is actually committed to the Libertarian Party and its affiliates. The fact that leaders have consistently suggested an openness to not running candidates against Republican opponents, running farcical candidates (see New Hampshire), and taking steps which intentionally alienate older members and generous donors, leads me to honestly suspect that the end of the Libertarian Party as we know it is not just a danger of their stewardship, but a goal.

And I can't take it anymore.



Putin is a liberal in the old fashioned sense that no longer exists in the West. He believes in sustaining a network of laws and agreements that resolve disputes diplomatically instead of with violence. He believes that government should serve the people and not the economic interests of the elite. He believes that religion is an important element of social unity and sustains moral behavior on which society depends. He is constrained in implementing his beliefs by Washington and Russian leadership elements that are pro-Western. This leaves Putin frustrated and angry.

Putin's views contrast sharply with what passes for liberalism in the West today. Western liberals teach race and gender hatred of white people and men. Morality for Western liberals is championing "transgender rights," such as the ability of men to declare themselves women and compete in female sports. Western liberals are active in reducing the informational content of language by erasing the use of gender pronouns. Liberals regard religion as the cause of wars and superstition. The sharp difference in views gives liberals many reasons to hate Putin. But these are not the main reasons Putin is hated.
