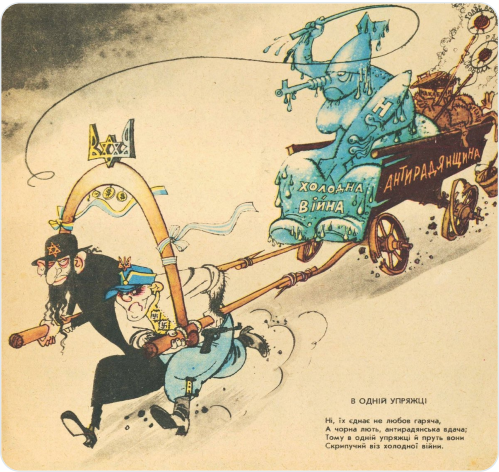

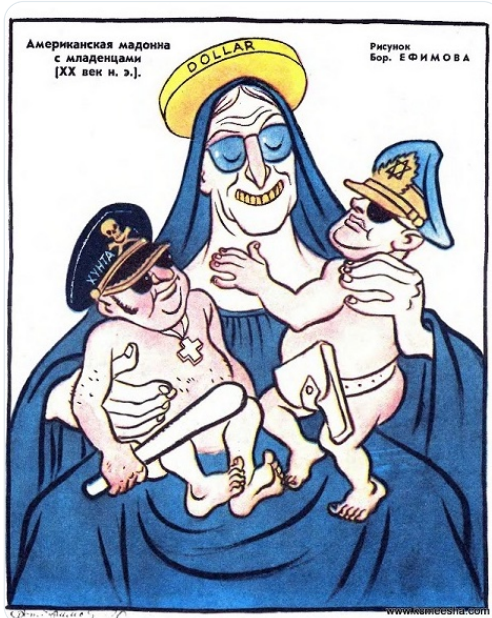

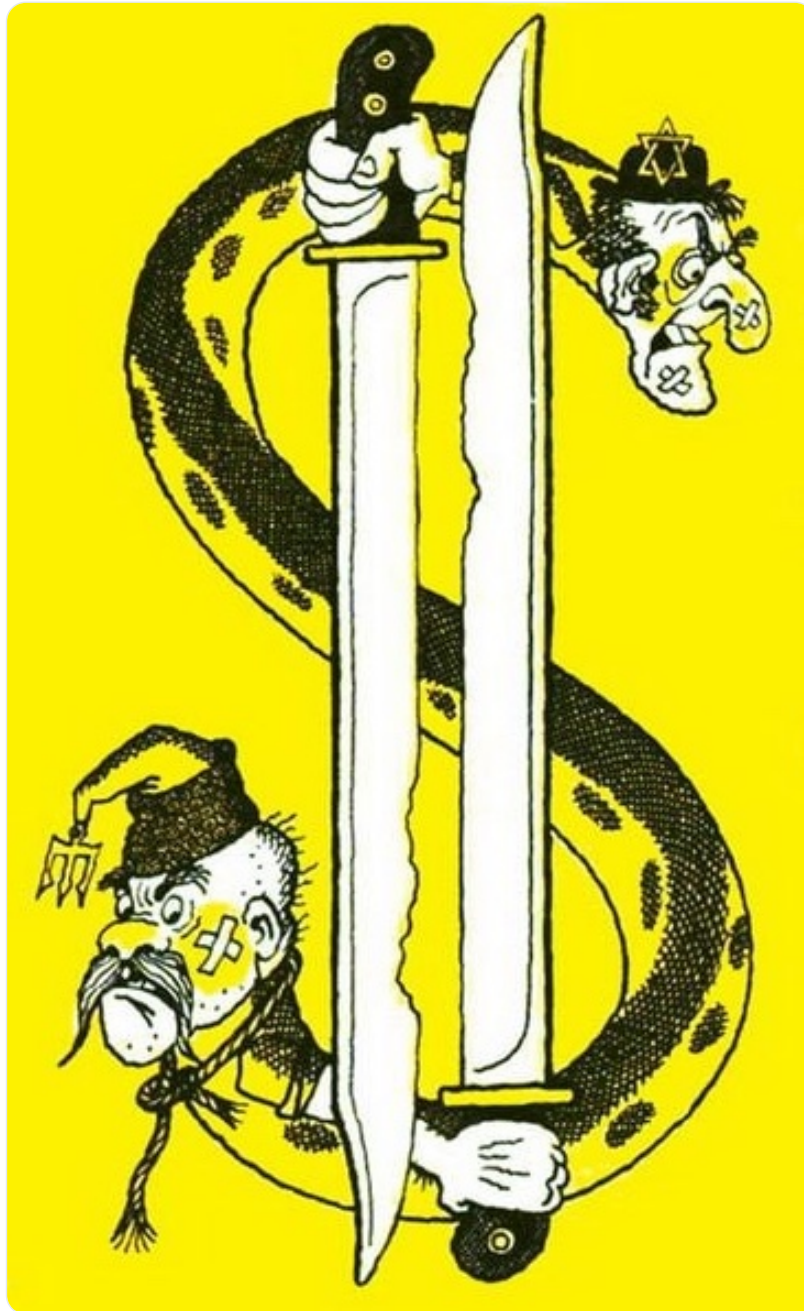

Here more Soviet anti-Semitic cartoons. Jews were compared to monkeys and accused to be "the new Nazis" (here on a cartoon: a "Zionist" studies construction plans of Nazi death camps he "wants to construct" for Palestinians). The USSR had created contemporary Western antisemitism
